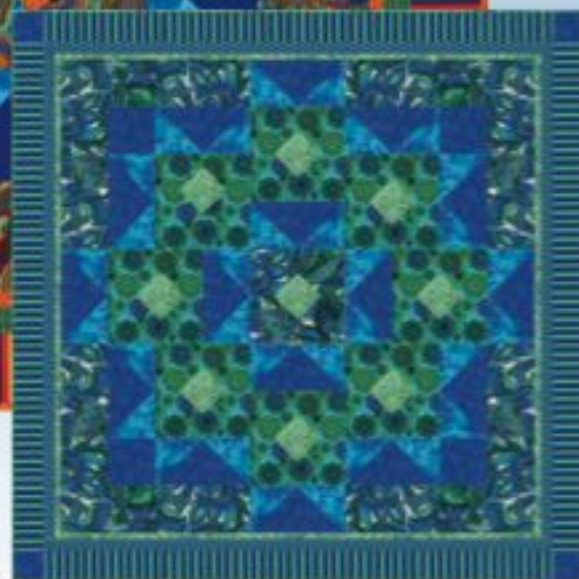

Fabric Requirements:

Bazaar Version

Fabric A: 2/3 yard of BTR-4611 Bazaar
Fabric B: 1/2 yard of BTR-4612 Bazaar
Fabric C: 1/4 yard of BTR-4614 Green
Fabric D: 1/2 yard of BTR-4615 Bazaar
Fabric E: 4-1/4 yards of BTR-4616 Amethyst
Fabric F: 3/4 yard of BTR-4616-Topaz
Fabric G: 2/3 yard of BTR-3504-Blue

Sahara Version

Fabric A: 2/3 yard of BTR-4611 Sahara
Fabric B: 1/2 yard of BTR-4612 Sahara
Fabric C: 1/4 yard of BTR-4614 Camel
Fabric D: 1/2 yard of BTR-4615 Sahara
Fabric E: 4-1/4 yards of BTR-4616 Black
Fabric F: 3/4 yard of BTR-4616 Tea
Fabric G: 2/3 yard of BTR-3504-Amber

Capri Version

Fabric A: 2/3 yard of BTR-4611 Capri
Fabric B: 1/2 yard of BTR-4612 Capri
Fabric C: 1/4 yard of BTR-4614 Capri
Fabric D: 1/2 yard of BTR-4615 Capri
Fabric E: 4-1/2 yards of BTR-4616 Lilac
Fabric F: 3/4 yard of BTR-3504 Seafoam
Fabric G: 2/3 yard of BTR-3504 Blue

Cutting Directions:

Fabric A: Cut four 4-1/2" squares

Cut four 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Cut four 4-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips

Fabric B: Cut twenty-four 4-1/2" squares

Fabric C: Cut two 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" strips

Cut two 1-1/2" x 43-1/2" strips

Fabric D: Cut four 3" x 43-1/2" strips

Fabric E: Cut four 3" squares

Cut four 4-1/2" squares

Cut sixteen 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips

Cut and piece fabric to fit quilt top

with 4" overlap (backing)

Fabric F: Cut thirty-six 2-1/2" squares

Cut two 1" x 40-1/2" strips

Cut two 1" x 41-1/2" strips

Cut five 2-1/4" strips (binding)

Fabric G: Cut thirty-two 4-1/2" squares

Block Assembly

1. Sew one Fabric F 2-1/2" square to one corner of a Fabric A 4-1/2" square. Sew across the square diagonally and flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away excess fabric 1/4" from the sewn seam (fig. 1). Make four blocks.
2. Sew these four units together with Fabric F triangle points all facing center (fig. 2) to complete one Fabric A 8" block.
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 above using Fabric B 4-1/2" squares and Fabric F 2-1/2" squares (fig 3). Make eight Fabric B 8" blocks.

Flying Geese Assembly

4. Sew one Fabric G 4-1/2" square to left side of one 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric E strip, right sides together. Sew across the square diagonally and flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 4). Trim away excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seam. Repeat for right side. Make 16 flying geese units.

Quilt Top Assembly

5. Refer to Figure 5 and join one Fabric B 8-1/2" block and two flying geese units together, using one Fabric E 4-1/2" square in corner. Fabric B blocks will be facing center of quilt. Make four 12-1/2" blocks. Sew remaining four Fabric B blocks to four flying geese units, making four 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" blocks.
6. Refer to Figure 6 and sew quilt blocks together, beginning with center, vertical row, ending with Fabric A 4-1/2" strips and flying geese units.
7. Attach first border by sewing two 1" x 40-1/2" Fabric F strips to left and right sides of quilt top. Sew two 2-1/2" x 41-1/2" strips of Fabric F strips to top and bottom of quilt top.
8. Attach second border by sewing two 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" Fabric C strips to left and right sides of quilt top. Sew two 2-1/2" x 43-1/2" strips of Fabric C strips to top and bottom of quilt top.
9. Attach third border by sewing two 3" x 43-1/2" Fabric D strips to left and right sides of quilt top. Sew two 3" Fabric E squares to left and right sides of two remaining 3" x 43-1/2" Fabric D strips and sew these strips to top and bottom of quilt top.
10. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

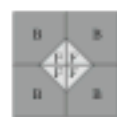

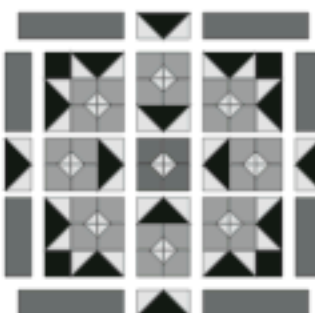
