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## Materials

*Yardages based on 42" wide fabric*

1 panel - Midnight Mischief (10160-1M)  
 7/8 Yard - Cream Toss (10161-2M)  
 1/3 Yard - Orange Leaves (10162-4)  
 1/3 Yard - Black Candy Corn (10163-1)  
 1/4 Yard - Blue Candy Corn (10163-3)  
 5/8 Yard - Black Tonal (10165-1M)  
 1/4 Yard - Yellow Tonal (10165-2M)  
 3/8 Yard - Orange Plaid (10164-4)  
 1/2 Yard - Binding - Blue Plaid (10164-3)  
 3 Yards - Backing of your choice  
 Suggested: Maroon Toss (10161-5M)

## Cut the Fabrics

*WOF = Width of Fabric*

### From the Cream Toss cut:

2 - 8 7/8" squares  
 2 - 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" strips  
 2 - 4 1/2" x 30 1/2" strips

### From the Orange Leaves cut:

15 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

### From the Black Candy Corn cut:

2 - 8 7/8" squares

### From the Blue Candy Corn cut:

16 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

### From the Black Tonal cut:

4 - 3 1/2" x WOF strips  
 15 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

### From the Yellow Tonal cut:

16 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

### From the Orange Plaid cut carefully, parallel to printed lines:

2 - 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" strips  
 2 - 2 1/2" x 28 1/2" strips

### From the Blue Plaid cut carefully

#### parallel to printed lines:

5 - 2 1/4" x WOF binding strips

### Assemble the Panel Center

1. Trim the Midnight Mischief panel to 21 1/2" x 23 1/2" (leaving at least 1/4" seam allowance outside the panel images.)
2. Sew a 3 1/2" Black Tonal strip to each long edge of the panel; press away from the panel. Trim the excess fabric from each edge of the black border strip (Fig. 1).

3. Sew a 3 1/2" Black Tonal strip to the top and bottom edges of the panel; press away from the panel. Trim the excess fabric from each edge of the black border strip.
4. Trim the panel, with borders added, to measure 26 1/2" x 28 1/2".

### Assemble the Piano Key Borders

1. Referring to the quilt photo for placement, sew sixteen 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles together as shown in the cover photo to make a 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" border strip; press in one direction. Sew a 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" Cream Toss rectangle along the long edge; press toward the cream. Repeat to make to a total of two side border strips. If the piano key strip is not the same length as the cream toss strip, adjust the piano key strip to fit.
2. Following the same process, make the top and bottom border strips by sewing fifteen 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles together to make a total of two 4 1/2" x 30 1/2" border strips. Press seams all in one direction. Sew a 4 1/2" x 30 1/2" Cream Toss rectangle along the long edge of each border strip; press toward the cream. If the piano key strip is not the same length as the cream toss strip, adjust the piano key strip to fit.

### Assemble the Corner Blocks

1. Pair a 8 7/8" Cream Toss square right sides together with a Black Candy Corn 8 7/8" square. Mark a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner on the wrong side of the Cream Toss square (Fig. 2).

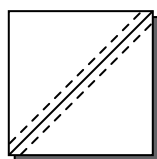

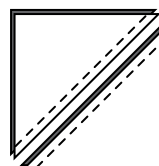

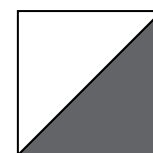

2. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the line and cut apart on the marked line (Fig. 3). Press open carefully to make a half square triangle (Fig. 4). Trim to 8 1/2" square.
3. Repeat to make a total of four half-square triangle corner blocks

### Assemble the Quilt

1. Sew a 2 1/2" x 28 1/2" Orange Plaid strip to the left and right sides of the quilt center; press towards the plaid. Sew a 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" Orange Plaid strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center; press toward the plaid.
2. Sew a 32 1/2" long Piano Key border strip the left and right sides of the quilt center; press toward the border.
3. Referring to the quilt photo for placement, sew a corner block to both ends of the 30 1/2" long Piano Key border strips. Sew these border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center; press toward the border.
4. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and baste. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting from around the borders and square the corners. Add the binding to the quilt.
